A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING CERTAIN PROPOSED CHANGES TO SECTION 18-2-8.5(a)(14) OF THE NORTHGLENN MUNICIPAL CODE, REGARDING REQUIREMENTS FOR PRIVATE SECURITY AT SPECIAL PRIVATE OCCASIONS

WHEREAS, Sections 18-2-8.5(a) and (b) of the Northglenn Municipal Code established a process by which individuals may obtain licenses to possess and consume alcoholic beverages for special private occasions in all public places within the City, including enclosed structures within City parks; and

WHEREAS, as currently drafted, pursuant to Section 18-2-8.5(a)(14), the City Clerk, in her discretion, may require the applicant to provide private security at the event as a condition of the license; and

WHEREAS, no standards currently exist establishing when security shall be required or establishing minimum requirements for the type of security required; and

WHEREAS, the Authority is concerned by that lack of guidance and would like to suggest that the City Council act to establish in the municipal code guidelines and minimum requirements for the provision of private security at such events.

NOW BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LIQUOR LICENSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF NORTHGLENN, THAT:

Section 1. The municipal code amendments proposed and attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, which would amend Section 18-2-8.5(a)(14) of the Northglenn Municipal Code to establish standards for the type of private security required at special private occasions, are hereby unanimously endorsed by the Liquor Licensing Authority and forwarded to the City Council for its consideration with a recommendation of approval.

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 18-2-8.5(a)(14) OF THE NORTHGLENN MUNICIPAL CODE TO ADD REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PROVISION OF PRIVATE SECURITY AT SPECIAL PRIVATE OCCASIONS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHGLENN, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. Section 18-2-8.5(a)(14) of the Northglenn Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows with deleted language appearing in ~~strike through~~ and new language appearing in ***bold italics***:

Section 18-2-8.5(a). Special Private Occasion Permit.

Upon approval by the Liquor Licensing Authority, the City Clerk may issue a special private occasion permit for the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages in all public places within the City of Northglenn, except for City Parks, provided the applicant can demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Liquor Licensing Authority that:

...

(14) The ***Liquor Licensing Authority*** ~~City Clerk~~ may consult with the Police Department regarding the need for security and, within its discretion ~~where appropriate~~, may require the provision of private security or the provision of a designated security representative, as those terms are defined below, at the applicant's expense as a condition to the issuance of a Special Private Occasion Permit.

- (A) ***If private security is required, the security shall be provided by an off-duty police officer who is currently P.O.S.T. certified, as that term is defined in C.R.S. § 24-3-301, et seq.***
- (B) ***If a designated security representative is required, the representative shall, prior to the event, submit a signed statement to the City Clerk indicating that he or she understands and accepts the responsibility to monitor the perimeter of the permitted area, to safely undertake crowd control efforts, and to call the police for assistance when appropriate.***
