<p><b>Request Summary:</b></p>	
<p>The applicant, AJO Holdings, LLC d/b/a High Society Medical Cannabis is requesting the Authority to grant a medical marijuana center license for the premises located at 920 W. 104<sup>th</sup> Avenue.</p>	
<p><b>Background Information:</b></p>	
<p>Northglenn Municipal Code Section 18-14-7(f) mandates the Authority to conduct a public hearing on all applications for a new medical marijuana center license. On March 24, 2014, the Authority set the public hearing on the application for April 14, 2014. The deadline was not met for the public hearing notice to be published in the Northglenn-Thornton Sentinel on April 3, 2014. As proper noticing did not occur pursuant to Northglenn Municipal Code Section 18-14-7(f), the public hearing cannot take place on April 14, 2014 as scheduled. The City Clerk’s Office requests that the public hearing be rescheduled for April 28, 2014 in order to accommodate publication of the public hearing notice. The applicant has been advised of the need to reschedule the public hearing.</p>	
<p><b>Action Needed:</b></p>	
<p>The Authority must reschedule the public rehearing on the application.</p>
