March 24, 2014**

**CALL TO ORDER** Mayor Downing called a meeting of the Northglenn Marijuana Licensing Authority to order on Monday, March 24, 2014 at 7:44 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers, 11701 Community Center Drive, Northglenn.

There was discussion regarding whether the community's needs are being met by existing medical marijuana centers and the applicant's ability to provide a unique product to the market.
