April 29, 2019**

**CALL TO ORDER** Mayor Dodge called a special meeting of the Northglenn City Council to order on Monday, April 29, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. in City Hall Council Chambers, 11701 Community Center Drive, Northglenn.

**INTERVIEWS:**

Amanda Bailhache Ms. Amanda Bailhache provided information about her background and experience as a public defender. Ms. Bailhache addressed questions from Council regarding her experience with nuisance abatements and code enforcement, and her knowledge of the Northglenn Municipal Court. Ms. Bailhache spoke about her philosophy related to juvenile defendants and probation, and provided ideas to improve procedures and efficiencies in the municipal court.

Lara Jimenez Ms. Lara Jimenez provided information about her background and experience as a district attorney for the 17<sup>th</sup> Judicial District. Ms. Jimenez addressed questions from Council regarding her knowledge of the Northglenn Municipal Court, her current schedule, and suggestions to improve efficiencies in the court. Ms. Jimenez spoke about her knowledge of the community, her professional accomplishments, and her interest in the position.

Kathryn Kurtz Ms. Kathryn Kurtz provided information about her background and experience as a prosecutor in the 1<sup>st</sup> Judicial District Attorney's Office and as a relief judge for the City of Lakewood. Ms. Kurtz addressed questions from Council regarding her experience with nuisance abatements and code enforcement, juvenile offenders and probation, and reporting to the City Council regarding the operation of the court. Ms. Kurtz spoke about her professional accomplishments, knowledge of the Northglenn Municipal Court, and her interest in the position.
