



PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS,** on June 30, 1959, the Perl-Mack Company began showing five model homes near 104th Avenue and what is now Interstate 25 with more than 15,000 people visiting the homes; and
- WHEREAS,** this pre-planned community was named the “most perfectly planned community in America” by Life Magazine and the National Association of Home Builders in 1961; and
- WHEREAS,** on October 13, 1964, residents voted to incorporate as a city and on January 31, 1969, the Adams County District Court upheld the vote and allowed the city to move ahead with incorporation; and
- WHEREAS,** on April 8, 1969, the first election was held, with 43 candidates going for 11 positions; and
- WHEREAS,** Hugh Danahy was elected as the first mayor and was sworn in with the other elected officials on April 18, 1969; and
- WHEREAS,** on April 19, 1969, “North Glenn” officially incorporated.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Carol Dodge, Mayor of the City of Northglenn, Colorado, hereby proclaim April 19, 2019 as:

INCORPORATION DAY

in the City of Northglenn in celebration of our 50th Anniversary.
