SUBJECT: CR-120, Acceptance of JAG Funds

RECOMMENDATION:

That Councilman's Resolution CR-120 be approved allowing the City of Northglenn to accept \$18, 863.00 in Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) funds for 2007.

BACKGROUND:

For the past several years the Northglenn Police Department has received federal funding from the Justice Assistance Grant (JAG). This grant is a combination of the former LLEBG and Edward Byrne Memorial Assistance Fund. This allocation is based on a predetermined formula. The formula basis for allocation of funds considers city and agency size, crime rate, arrests, and drug related activity. These funds will be used for technology improvements.
