**WHEREAS,** it is the privilege and duty of the American people to commemorate the 234<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America with appropriate ceremonies and activities; and

**WHEREAS,** every American shares in this legacy of liberty, and we are grateful for the courage, conviction, and sacrifice of all those who have helped preserve and uphold the principles of a free society. As we remember the enduring importance of the Constitution, we also recognize our responsibility to respect and defend the values of our founding, and participate in the unfolding story of freedom; and

**WHEREAS,** in celebration of the signing of the Constitution and in recognition of the Americans who strive to uphold the duties and responsibilities of citizenship, the Congress, by joint resolution of August 2, 1956, requested that the week beginning September 17<sup>th</sup> and ending September 23<sup>rd</sup> of each year be proclaimed as "Constitution Week."
