Transportation Planning Update

Mr. Jim Hayes, Planning and Development Director, provided a quarterly transportation planning update. Mr. Hayes spoke about the Regional Transportation District (RTD) FasTracks project and the timeline for the Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) for the North Metro Line. Mr. Hayes also spoke about the North Area Transportation Alliance (NATA), the Adams Movers Group (AMG), and the Collaborative Transportation Planning Agreement that was approved by Council in 2010.

Dr. Sean Reif, Ward I, spoke about eliminating unnecessary programs, communicating with residents and businesses, and complying with open meetings laws. Dr. Sean Reif, Ward I, spoke against CB-1734 and expressed concern about the possibility of the Planning Commission not meeting at least once per month to allow public input.

Dr. Sean Reif, Ward I, spoke against CB-1735. Dr. Reif expressed concern about the language used within the document and stated he feels it is difficult for lay people to understand.

Dr. Reif was questioned by Council regarding sections of the ordinance relating to fencing, paving, dust control, noise, drainage, and wildlife mitigation. Dr. Reif indicated that, with the exception of paving, he did not have specific issues with the provisions.

City Attorney Hoffmann stated that he had received email

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

Recycling Program

Council member Clyne spoke about the status of the curbside recycling program. Council member Clyne inquired about the need for a second survey regarding interest in recycling and stated she would like to proceed with the implementation of the program.

There was discussion about the initial survey results, the intent of a subsequent survey, and determining the feasibility of a curbside recycling program. There was discussion about providing recycling polycarts to residents at no charge, encouraging residents to participate in a recycling program, and gathering information to determine how many carts will be needed.

There was discussion about implementing the program as soon as possible. City Manager Simmons spoke about how the survey results will be used and noted that it is not staff's intent to distribute recycling carts in the winter.

COMMUNICATIONS:

Council member Carrico reported on the North Metro Fire Rescue District's grand opening event for their new administration building, and noted that the District will still have a presence in the City with its fire stations. Council member Carrico reported that the Wright Farms Library branch is now open on Sundays and encouraged residents to use the facility and take advantage of the Library's educational programs.

Council member Clyne reported on the Finance Committee's meeting and noted that they had reviewed the City's investment policy.

Council member Snetzinger congratulated Michael Stricker, Recreation Programs Supervisor, on his recent awards for acting and directing from the Denver Post and local theatre reviewer David Marlowe. Council member Snetzinger also congratulated Jim Hayes, Planning and Development Director, for his recent appointment to the Executive Board of the Colorado Chapter of the American Planning Association.
