


**SUBJECT:** CR – 45, 2011 Traffic Signal Improvements Contract

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**BACKGROUND**

During the January 20, 2011 Study Session, staff presented the proposed 2011 Infrastructure Maintenance Programs to City Council for discussion and endorsement. The proposed traffic signal improvements for 2011 include the cleaning and painting of the traffic signal poles, mast arms and luminaires on 104<sup>th</sup> Avenue. The traffic signal assemblies are experiencing extensive corrosion that can adversely affect their structural integrity.

On March 29, 2011, the City accepted three (3) formal bids for the 2011 Traffic Signal Improvements Project. The low bid was from **WL Contractors, Inc.** in the amount of \$67,970.00. The approved budget for this project is \$50,000.00. City staff reduced the scope of the contract to fit within the approved budget. The scope was reduced to include the seven intersections deemed to be in the worst condition.

**THIS AGREEMENT**, made this \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_, by and between the City of Northglenn, hereinafter called "CITY", and WL Contractors, Inc., hereinafter called "CONTRACTOR".

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the payments and agreements hereinafter mentioned:

1. The CONTRACTOR will commence and complete the project named:

**"2011 Traffic Signal Improvements Project"**

2. The CONTRACTOR will furnish all of the materials, supplies, tools, equipment, labor supervision, and other services necessary for the completion of the PROJECT described herein.

3. The CONTRACTOR will provide performance and payment bonds and a certificate of insurance naming the City as an additional insured for purposes of said project within 10 days after the date of the NOTICE OF AWARD.

4. The CONTRACTOR agrees to perform all of the WORK described in the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS and comply with the terms therein for the sum of \$49,665.00, or as shown in the BID schedule. The CONTRACTOR will commence the work within 10 calendar days after the date of NOTICE TO PROCEED. The CONTRACTOR will complete the work within 40 working days after the date of NOTICE TO PROCEED unless the period for completion is extended otherwise by the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS.

5. The term "CONTRACT DOCUMENTS" means and includes all items as set forth in Section 1.01 of the General Conditions.

6. The CITY will pay to the CONTRACTOR in the manner and at such times as set forth in the General Conditions such amounts as required by the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS.

7. This AGREEMENT shall be binding upon all parties hereto and their respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed, or caused to be executed by their duly authorized officials, this Agreement in TWO copies, each of which shall be deemed an original on the date first above written.
