RESPONSIBLE FOR THE MISTREATMENT.

PURPOSE: THIS BILL AMENDS THE CITY'S ANIMAL PROTECTION ACT TO

ALLOW THE MUNICIPAL COURT, ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER, POLICE OFFICER, OR OTHER PUBLIC OFFICIAL TO REMOVE AN ANIMAL THAT HAS BEEN MISTREATED FROM THE POSSESSION OF THE PERSON RESPONSIBLE FOR MISTREATING IT, PROVIDED THERE IS PROBABLE CAUSE TO BELIEVE A VIOLATION OF THE ANIMAL CONTROL ACT HAS OCCURRED. MOREOVER, THE AMENDMENT GIVES THE MUNICIPAL COURT THE AUTHORITY TO REMOVE THE ANIMAL INVOLVED FROM THE POSSESSION OF ANY PERSON CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF THE ANIMAL PROTECTION ACT.
