SUBJECT: CR-106 – ADCOM Interagency Data Sharing Agreement

PURPOSE

To consider CR-106, a resolution approving an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with Adams County Communications Center Authority (ADCOM) for interagency data sharing.

BACKGROUND

ADCOM is the main agency in the Interagency Data Sharing Agreement, and the sub-agencies are the Adams County Sheriff's Office (ACSO) and the cities of Brighton, Commerce City, Federal Heights, and Northglenn.

The City is a member agency of ADCOM, which provides police dispatch and related services to the Northglenn Police Department.

In the past, ADCOM provided records management using CentralSquare Technologies for all the aforementioned agencies. However, ACSO is no longer utilizing ADCOM to provide records management services as they have their own CentralSquare system. This change necessitates a data-sharing agreement between all parties involved.

The shared information includes criminal justice records and other reports. By sharing information, it makes all facets of law enforcement more efficient, including investigations, criminal histories, and arrestee transfers.

All agencies involved have agreed to follow the proper security policies for the transfer, sharing and storage of data.

BUDGET/TIME IMPLICATIONS

All costs are covered as part of the City's IGA with ADCOM. There are no time impacts.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of CR-106, a resolution that, if approved, would authorize the Mayor to execute the ADCOM Interagency Data Sharing Agreement on behalf of the City.

No Data will be shared with any Agency (Main or Sub) absent a copy of this document being on file with CentralSquare Technologies, LLC.
