Distributed \$74K in nutritious and culturally-relevant food to over 6,691 farmers market attendees, serving residents and families in 12 USDA low-income/low-access zip codes.



Conducted direct outreach to 1,141 community organizations to establish critical relationships and partnerships to improve community health and well-being.



Participated in over 200 community events across the County, meeting community members where they are.



Conducted nearly 2,300 routine inspections of licensed facilities (retail food, body art, child care, recreational water) to assure healthy and safe conditions.



Provided \$11.3M in WIC food benefits to nearly 11,000 active participants in Adams County (~26% increase from 2022).



Administered over 5,600 immunizations.

43% of immunization clients use Spanish as primary, preferred language.



Served over 400 Adams County families with intensive Nurse Home visitation programming to increase family resiliency.



Provided comprehensive sexual health services to nearly 900 unduplicated patients.

80% of whom are at or below 100% the Federal Poverty Level.




Expanded clinic hours for Immunizations and Sexual Health services to increase access outside of normal 8am-5pm business hours.






