Update

Director of Parks, Recreation, and Culture Amanda Peterson introduced the Traffic Signal Cabinet Wraps Art Project, which aims to enhance Northglenn's cityscape with cohesive two-dimensional public art. Recreation Manager Michael Stricker and Artist Julia Williams presented the final proposed designs, stating the vibrant and engaging artwork is intended to foster community pride and cultural conversations.

Council members praised the design's vibrancy, modern aesthetic, and alignment with community values while appreciating its distinction from marketing materials. They expressed appreciation for the thoughtful balance between artistic expression and community identity and provided consensus to move forward with the final designs.
